Proposition 72

Requires employers to protect your health care coverage and keep your costs down. Prop 72 requires all large companies to pay for health insurance for workers that includes:

- Prescription Drugs
 - Preventive Care
 - Major Medical



3 Reasons to Vote Yes on Prop 72

Safeguards Your Private Health Insurance

- Requires your employer to continue providing health coverage
- Prop 72 limits the amount you have to pay for health insurance

Makes Wal-Mart and Saves Tax Dollars Other Large **Companies Pay** Their Fair Share

- Over 80% of the people who don't have health insurance in California are in working families
- Prop 72 will require nonunion companies like Wal-Mart to provide good affordable health insurance for its workers

- We pay \$4.6 billion in taxes when uninsured workers have to use emergency rooms for basic health care
- Prop 72 will require that employers, not taxpayers, pay for health care for working families
